



Privacy Statement for swebber.eu

swebber.eu may collect and use the following types of personal information:

- Information that you provide to us for the purpose of processing a business transaction
- Information that you provide to us through contact forms or external downloads such as name, email address, telephone number, mailing address and company to request information about our software or services.
- Where permitted, swebber.eu may collect information about certain individuals and companies obtained by other parties. This helps us to keep our records up to date, expand and analyze them. But also to identify new customers and offer products and services that may be of interest to you.

swebber.eu may use your personal information to:

- Process your request regarding our software or services, including downloading white papers.
- Collect or send to you your statements, invoices, or payments
- Offer you relevant marketing messages such as email newsletters, marketing information, service offers. All according to the new laws or when requested by you.
